Please include a two-page extended abstract in Times New Roman, 12-point font. The two pages must include figures, tables, and references. See footnotes for specific information regarding section headings, paragraph style, figure captions, table titles, footnotes, equations, and references. Your accepted abstract will be published as received in a Book of Abstracts given to all Workshop participants.

Authors of accepted abstracts are invited to bring three copies of the final manuscripts to the meeting to be submitted to Springer Publishing for possible inclusion in *Microsystems Technologies* journal. The manuscripts should follow the Springer guidelines that can be found on the HARMST2003 website. These guidelines for the extended abstract follow as closely as possible the Springer manuscript guidelines.

<sup>1</sup> Make sure figure lettering is large enough. Use 5-cm-long line above footnote.

- **Paper Size and Margins.** Use standard letter paper (8.5" wide x 11" long) with 1" margins.
- **Author name(s).** Left justify in 12-point Times New Roman font, small capital letters. Include all author names in full. Put one blank lines below the names.
- **Author affiliations and addresses.** Left justify in italics, 12-point Times New Roman font with upper/lowercase letters. For more than one affiliation, use superscripted symbols or letters (a,b). Include the email, phone, and fax of the communicating author in 10-point Times New Roman font below the address. Put two blank lines below addresses.
- **Extended Abstract.** Use 12-point Times New Roman font and single-spaced text. Use section headings as desired. Fully justify the text (aligned left and right).
- **Headings.** Use 12-point, left-justified text. For first-level headings, use **bold** and in upper/lowercase letters. For second-level headings, use **bold** and underline. For third-level headings, use *italics* and upper/lowercase.
- **Paragraph style.** Do not indent paragraphs. Put one blank line between paragraphs.
- **Figure captions, table titles and text, and footnotes.** Use 10-point size and single space without blank lines. Use short title, centered, with Table and Figure in all caps and bold (e.g., **TABLE 1.** Short Title and **FIGURE 1.** This is a caption.).
- **Equations.** Center equations. Number sequentially on right hand size in parentheses—for example, (1).
- **References.** Use 9-point Times New Roman. See examples below for journal article and book. Refer to by number in brackets—e.g., [1]—in the paper.
